Our corporate headquarters are based in Nashville, Tennessee and we currently have over 3,900 employees based in 51 locations across 26 countries including a significant presence in major financial centres like New York, London, Hong Kong and Tokyo.

### **Programme information**

AB joined the Investment20/20 program back in 2019, we launched several roles across our Client & Marketing Group, Multi Asset Investment and Operations teams. This year we plan to add more Investment20/20 roles across our business in our Compliance, Investment Management and Broker Dealer Operations and Client Group teams.

You will join as a trainee as part of the Client Group SBU. While we can't guarantee a permanent position at the end of the 12-month contract, it is our intention to make the offer, but this is up to how well you perform. Seventy-five percent of our Investment20/20 trainees were offered permanent positions from our initial cohort.

Our traineeship will introduce you to investment management and you will gain industry knowledge, experience and develop relationships enabling you to progress your career and provide you with skills to secure a permanent role. As you progress in your role, we will support you in achieving a professional qualification if this is something you are interested in doing. As part of the Investment20/20 program, you will have opportunities to meet and network with over 200 trainees across the industry and participate in socials and insight events.

Our trainee program is a fixed term one-year contract paying £22,000 per annum. You will receive 25 days annual leave. You will also qualify for participation in our non-contributory pension scheme as well as being invited to join other company benefit schemes should you wish to do so. All roles are based in London.

### **Programme Summary**

This is a programme intended to give you a breadth of knowledge and experience within the business to enable you to make informed decisions about where you would like to develop your career.

### **The Team**

Global Product Strategy and Development, part of the Global Client Group, is responsible for creating and managing AllianceBernstein's range of pooled investment funds. There are currently seven members of the team based in London supporting the European based fund ranges. The Market

Intelligence function supports both Product Strategy and Development in assessing new and existing funds as well as the wider European sales team.

The trainee will learn: about European based investment funds and strategies; about investment trends and to monitor and analyse them; how to use and analyse investment trend databases; and how to aggregate and present information for use by the business and senior leaders.

**Responsibilities include, but not exclusively**

- Main responsibility will be regular reporting on European investment trends, eg: sales and performance broken out by region, investment type, etc.
- Sourcing information from internal and external data providers and processing into report templates (Excel, PowerPoint, PowerBI) for use by various members of the Client Group.
  - These reports help make decisions such as what investments to sell, who to sell to, and what new investment products to create. No prior knowledge is required and training will be provided on how to use on how to use external databases such as Morningstar, Broadridge, eVestment, Simfund.

**Additional responsibilities include:**

- Tracking data publications from trade bodies, regulators, and other professional bodies for distribution to relevant teams.
- Assisting in completion of external surveys requested by clients and external data providers.
- Assisting in maintenance of AB's data quality in external databases.
- Assisting in development of internal sites to house regular and ad-hoc reports

**Requirements**

If you've just finished your A-levels or your BTECs and have an interest in working in data analysis or data science within financial services and have the following attributes, we are interest in hearing from you:

- Team player, but also able to work effectively alone;
- Inquisitive and enjoy interpreting information and problem solving;
